3. Of the three main narrators—Chloe, Charles and Andre—which did you relate to the most? Who did you empathize with the most with and why?
4. The reader eventually discovers that Andre isn't really a psychopath but is only pretending to be one. When did you realize he wasn't a psychopath? Why do you think he lied to the others?
5. At the start of the book, Chloe is on a mission to kill Will Bachman because of what he did to her as a child. Does Chloe feel better after completing her goal? How does being a psychopath change her relationship to this trauma?
6. Chloe lies, cheats, steals, and eventually murders. By most standards, she's not a "likeable" character. What about her makes her a fun character to follow? Did you ever find yourself rooting for her?
7. Were you surprised to learn who was murdering the psychopathic students? Was her motivation justifiable? Why or why not?
8. This is Vera Kurian's first book - would you read a second novel written by her?
